

## **PETERBOROUGH FABIAN SOCIETY PRIVACY NOTICE**

1. Peterborough Fabian Society will collect and use your personal data in compliance with the law. The society is the data controller of any personal information we hold about you. This means that we are responsible for complying with data protection laws.
2. We receive and process personal data about members of the national Fabian Society, supplied by the national society, in order to supply one of the benefits of national membership (access to local Fabian Society events). Our purpose in using this data is to promote our membership and activities, which is lawful on the basis of our legitimate interests as a political society. National members can opt-out of all communications.
3. We collect and process personal data about other individuals for the purpose of membership administration and promoting our activities, when they give direct consent. Recipients can opt-out of all communications.
4. We will not transfer personal data to third-parties, with the following exceptions: (1) data about members of the local society will be passed to the national Fabian Society for the purpose of affiliation and membership administration; (2) when individuals have directly consented to their data being shared with another party; (3) to providers of our technology systems under strict conditions. The national Fabian Society will only communicate with you using data supplied to us, if you consent to this.
5. The personal information we hold may include name and contact details e.g. email address
6. We are committed to keeping your personal data secure and will ensure that all electronic and paper records are securely stored and protected. Our communications will not reveal your personal data to others.
7. We will only keep your data as long as is necessary to fulfil the purposes for which we hold it.
8. You have the following rights with respect to your data: the right to be informed about the data we hold and why/how we use it; the right to access your data; the right to rectify errors; the right to ask for data to be erased; the right to restrict how the data is processed; the right to move your data; the right to object to how data is used and to opt-out of electronic communications. Some of these rights may be restricted in certain circumstances.
